⇒ In a notable step forward, the International Journal of the Jurisprudence of the Family will be included in Lexis-Nexis databases. This is a great achievement for the Journal. Also, from now on, the Journal will have to be peer reviewed. We count on the Fellows of the Academy to assist in implementing this new measure.

⇒ We are now within the period set forth in the Academy by-laws for the nomination of officers and members of Academy Board of Directors. The deadline for nominations is May 9th. Those members interested in present candidacies should proceed according to the By-laws of the Academy (please check Article VII).

⇒ The Board of Directors has decided to create an annual award, named after Richard Wilkins, to reward achievements in the field of the jurisprudence of the family. The first Richard Wilkins Award will be conferred at the 2013 symposium described in the next item of this bulletin.

NEXT IASJF SYMPOSIUM

⇒ There are new developments relating to the next symposium of the IASJF, which will be held at Cardozo Law School in New York City on June 10-11, 2013, and which will address "Privacy, Autonomy, and Should States Regulate Family Relations?". More than 50 paper proposals were submitted by the deadline. The definitive program will be posted on the Academy webpage (www.iasjf.org) by the end of April.
