⇒ The annual Symposium of the Academy was held at Cardozo Law School in New York City on June 10-11, 2013, on the subject of "Privacy, Autonomy, and Should States Regulate Family Relations?". It was the most comprehensive Academy symposium to date, having the largest number of presenters and the largest number of countries represented. This reflects widening recognition of the Academy, and is especially impressive in light of the fact that participants were expected to pay their own way and received no honoraria.
