MEMBERS AWARDS AND APPOINTMENTS

⇒ Ursula Basset, Professor of the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Santa María de los Buenos Aires, in Argentina, and Member of the Executive Board of Directors of the IASJF, has been distinguished with the Accedit Prize of the National Academy of Jurisprudence on behalf of her book "Calificación de bienes en la sociedad conyugal". This is one of the most prestigious prizes in the juridical field in Argentina, and Professor Basset is one of the youngest scholars to achieve such a honor.
